Stages in a Relationship

- Romance

Stages of Intimacy

- Hugging

Erogenous Zones

- Lips Respond to kissing, gentle touching with fingers, sucking on, or nibbling
- Eyelids Respond to gentle brush with fingertips or tongue
- Eyebrow Area Respond to gentle rub or lick
- Ears Respond to gentle suck of the earlobe or probe of inner ear with tongue
- *Neck* Respond to gentle suck and lick
- *Hair* Respond to gentle pull of the hair
- Nipples Respond to gentle swirl of the tongue around or gentle bite
- Breast Area Respond to light caress or lick of the valley between the breasts
- Inner Arms/Inner Thighs Respond to gentle run of hands or fingers along the areas or light kisses
- *Hands/Fingers* Respond to light run a finger over the palm or underside of fingers
- Knees Respond to light touch and lick the hollow behind the knees
- Feet/Toes Respond to an erotic foot massage or light run of a finger along the soles and toes
- Navel Respond to a light lick of the perimeter of the navel or a plunge of tongue into navel
- Buttocks Respond to gentle pinch, lick, bite, or massage
